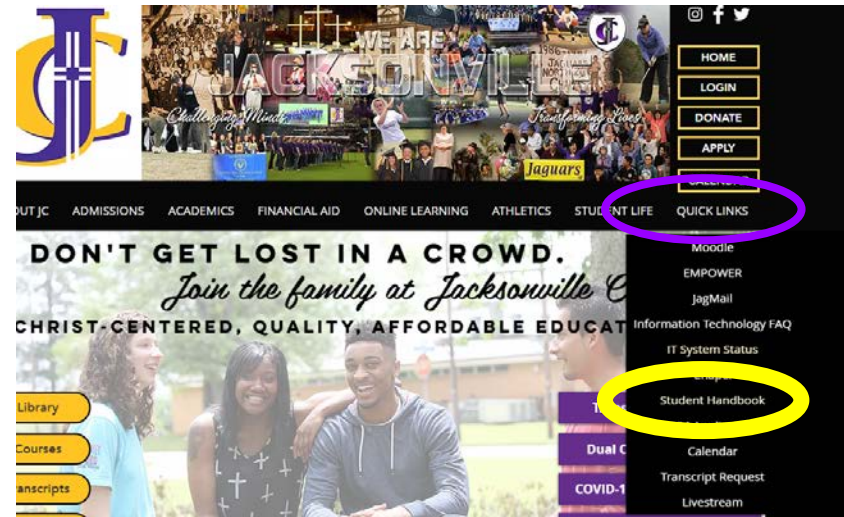
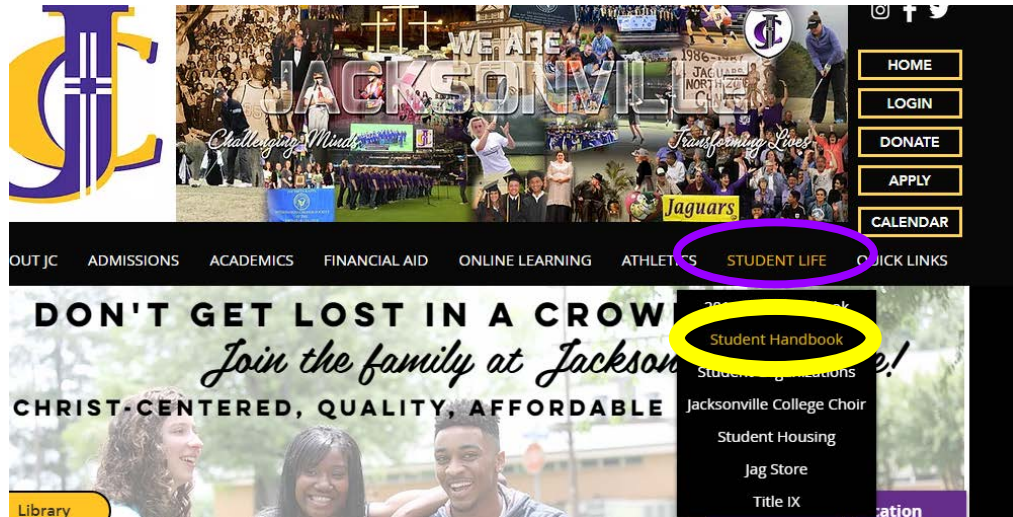

What did I agree to?

- Student Code of Conduct (pg. 33)
- Applies to all students
- Additional housing rules apply to students living on campus

What did I agree to?

- **Violations may result in fines from \$25-\$500, suspension or expulsion (on your transcript for life)**
- Dishonesty (verbally or in print; in and out of classroom)
- Disorderly Conduct (includes excessive noise), disruption or obstruction of teaching, administration, procedures or activities
- Failure to comply with College Officials (not wearing or showing ID when asked)
- Breaking the law, property damage, unauthorized use or tampering, theft or abuse of computer access, hardware and/or software
- Use or possession of alcohol or illegal drugs, firearms, explosives, fireworks, ammunition, or any weapon (including toy weapons)
- Gambling, pornography, foul language, sexual misconduct (includes heterosexual, homosexual, bisexual, transgenderism, and any other form)
- Physical or verbal abuse, harassment of any kind, hazing, bullying

What did I agree to?

Dress Code (pg. 38)

Students can be fined and may ultimately result in expulsion!!!

Girls:

- DON'T show cleavage or uncovered midriffs.
- DO make sure your shorts, dresses, or skirts are at least fingertip length.
- Tight elements and leggings may be worn as undergarments, but not as outerwear unless paired with tops, dresses, or skirts at least fingertip length.

Guys:

- DON'T wear sagging clothing and/or enlarged arm openings in shirts.

What did I agree to?

Dress Code (pg. 38):

Athletic wear (i.e running shorts, cropped and muscle shirts) is acceptable during practice and competitive events only:

- DON'T wear it outside of student housing facilities and the athletic practice areas.

- DON'T enter ANY other building on campus until you've changed.

- DO wear shoes.

- DON'T wear sleepwear outside of student housing (don't be a "people of Walmart")

- DO take your cap, hat and/or hoodie off inside the chapel, cafeteria and library.

- DO cover up all piercings (except for earrings).

What did I agree to?

PDA (pg. 41):

-DO not engage in behavior that is considered sexual misconduct, sexual harassment, or an inordinate display of affection that is offensive to good taste.

-**Guys** are **NOT** allowed in girls dorms or housing.

-**Girls** are **NOT** allowed in guys dorms or housing.

-Sexual activity between unmarried individuals on JC campus is not allowed.

-Physical contact between male and female students will be monitored.

-Holding hands is the only acceptable form of contact allowed.

-When sitting by each other, male and female students should always be in an upright position.

How do I access an official and unofficial transcript?

Official transcripts are requested through the Jacksonville College website. The only way to obtain an official transcript for another college, a coach or a job is by requesting one through the link on our homepage or under QUICK LINKS.

Unofficial transcripts are accessible through your EMPOWER account. You can save and send an unofficial as needed yourself.

What is the law regarding college students and disciplinary withdrawal?

- Any student withdrawn from an institution due to disciplinary reasons (in other words not due to failing grades or failure to pay your bill) **WILL** have this transcribed on their academic transcript.

Remember that you have to send a transcript from all institutions you have attended to any institution you are trying to go to. This will now be on your transcript for the remainder of your life. Think before you act and speak!

Am I going to graduate in May?

The Registrar's Office will be sending out emails to students eligible to graduate or participate in our May commencement ceremony to college email accounts by 1/15/2021 (Friday).

- The email will have a link to the graduation application and indicate whether you are potentially eligible to graduate in May or participate in May and complete coursework and graduate in August. Please read the email carefully to discern which applies to you. If you have any questions, please email us at registrar@jacksonville-college.edu immediately so we can resolve any issues.

Am I going to graduate in May?

If you have NOT received an email from Registrar's Office by end of day on Friday and think you should be graduating in May, please contact us immediately via email at registrar@jacksonville-college.edu.

- DON'T assume you are graduating. You must have an email from the Registrar's Office confirming your eligibility to do so. If you do not receive an email and think you are eligible to graduate contact us immediately via email.
